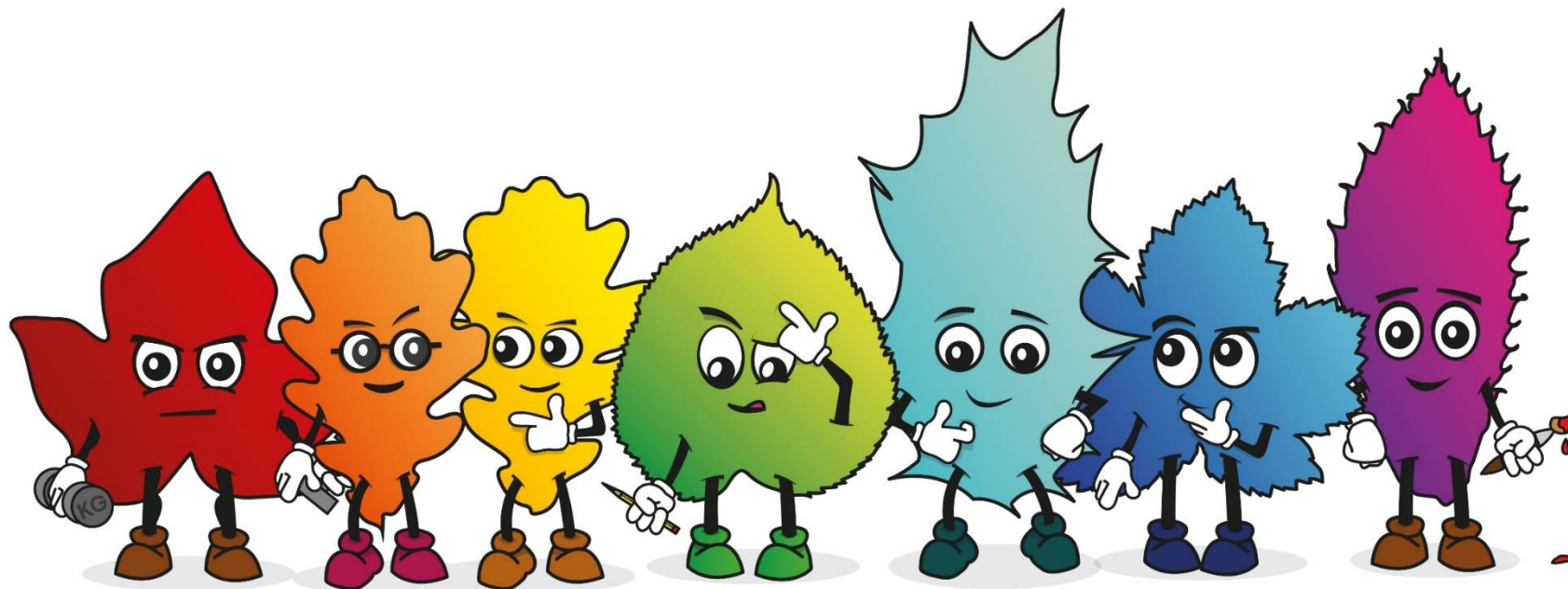

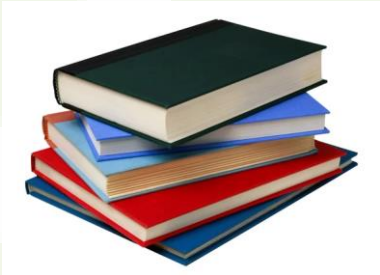

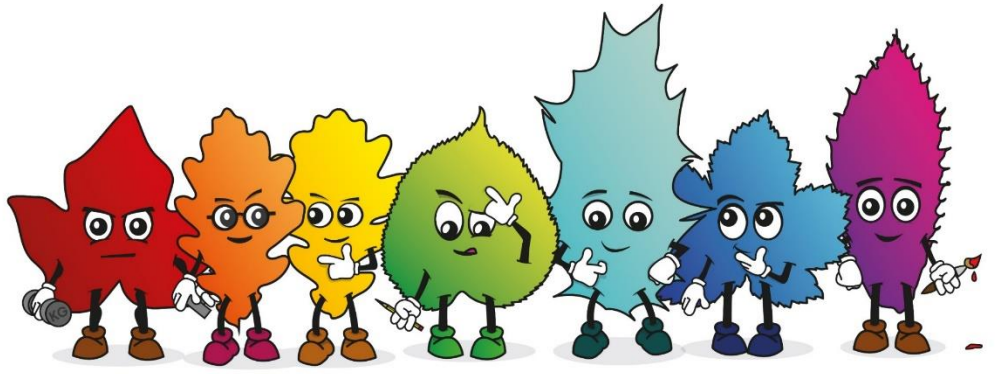
At Freegrounds Junior School we **aspire**-to aim high, **believe**– in who we are and **achieve**-beyond our dreams.

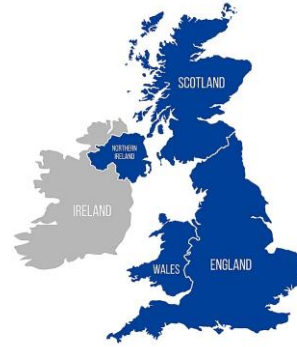

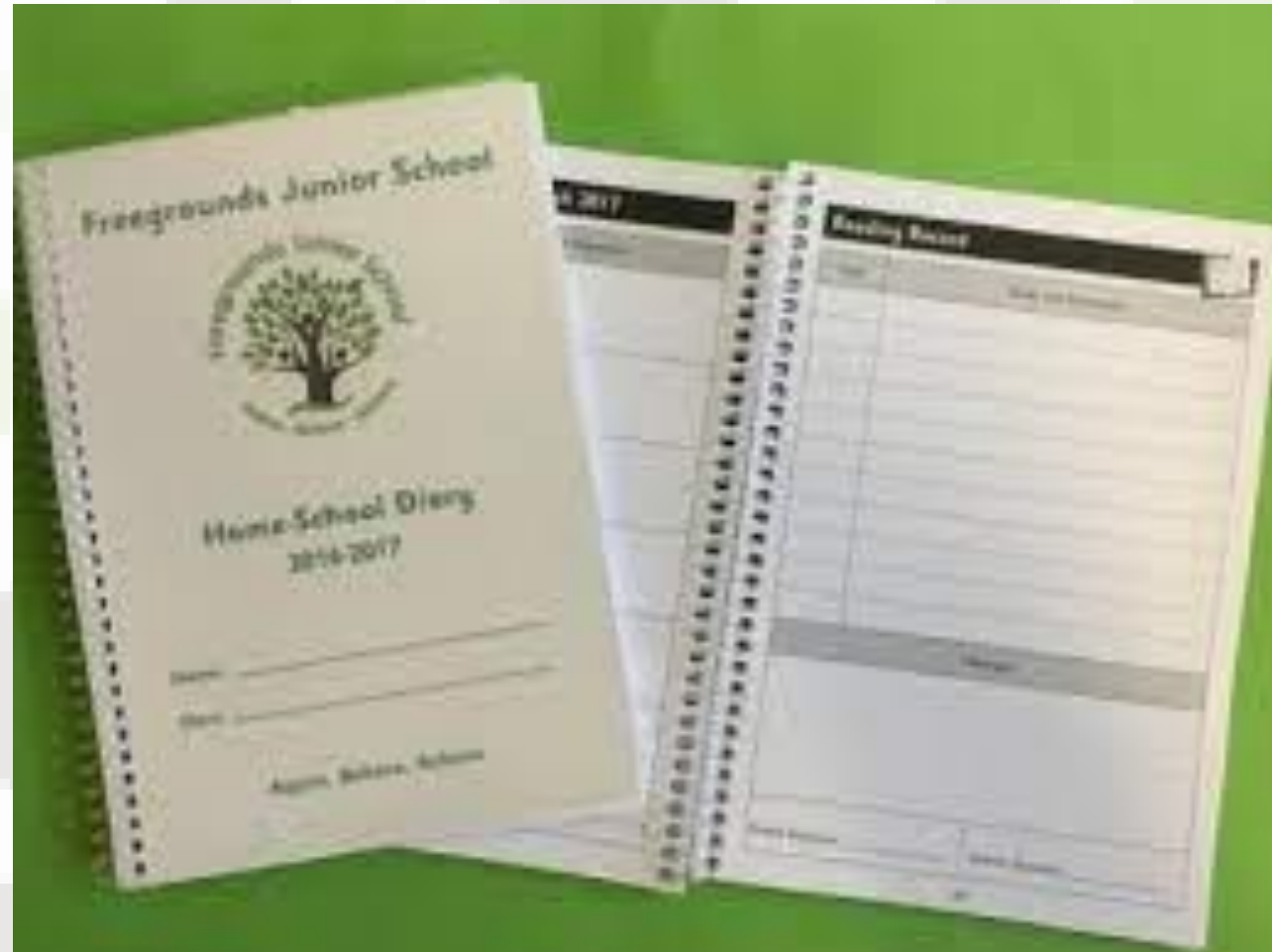

It is a national expectation for all children to have rapid recall of multiplication facts up to 12×12 by the end of Year 4. At Freegrounds Junior School we believe that rapid recall means that children are able to provide an answer to a times tables question, presented to them at random, within three seconds.

Reading...

- Children earn a house point every time they record 20 reads in their Home School Diary
- Children are entered into a raffle prize draw each week if they have read three or more times
- In year 3 children should be continuing to work on reading sight words, segmenting and blending
- They will be beginning to read with increased fluency and adding appropriate intonation and expression
- At school, the focus will be on comprehension skills such as inference and understanding of vocabulary.



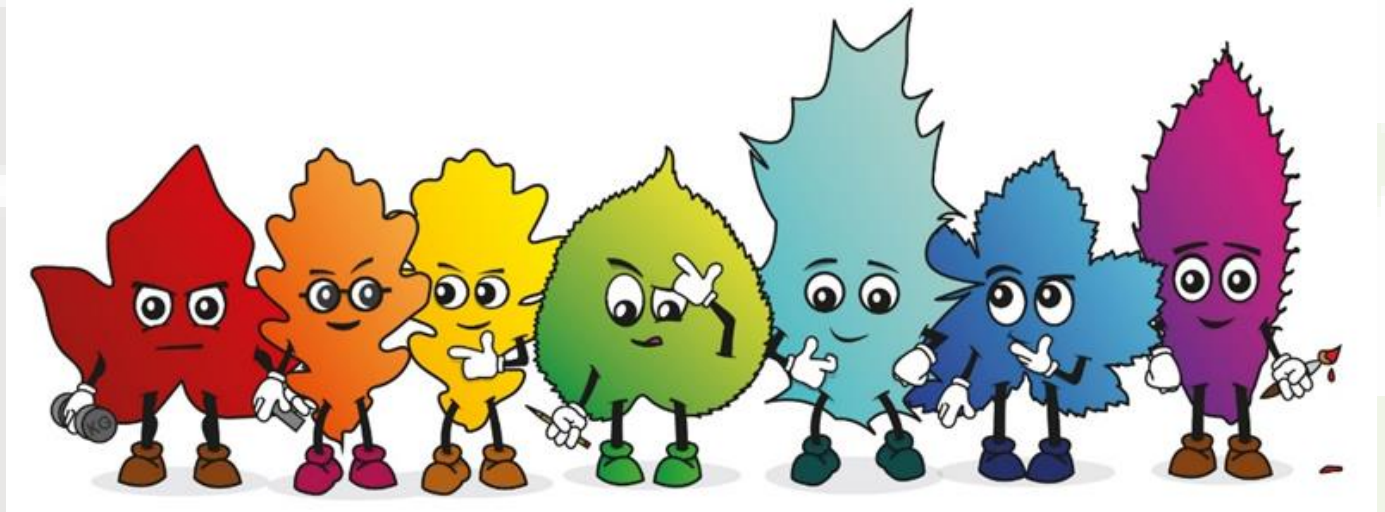

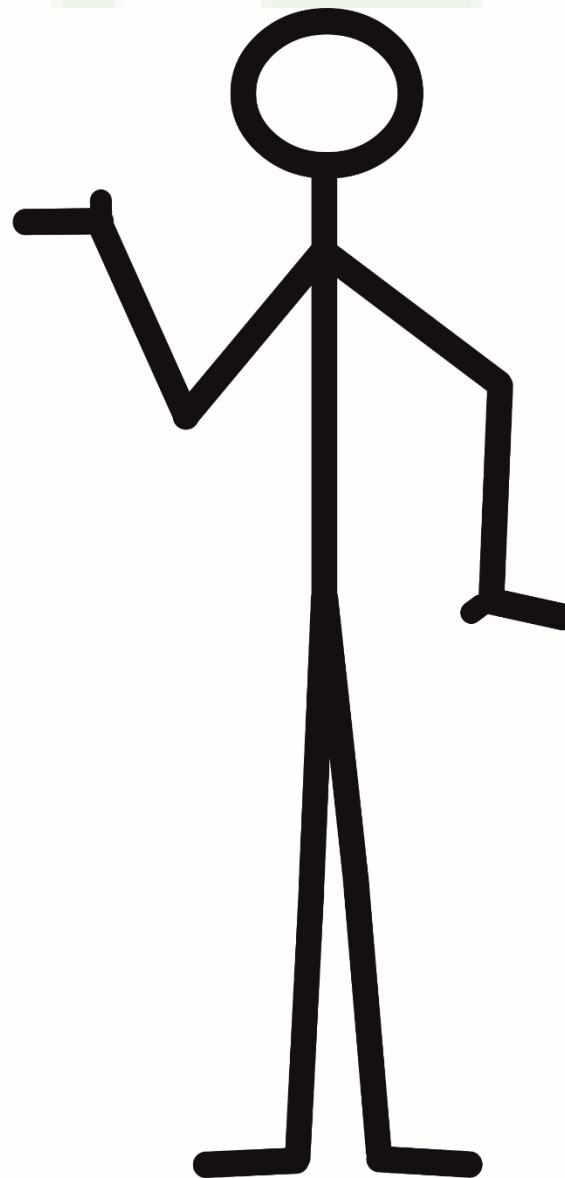
