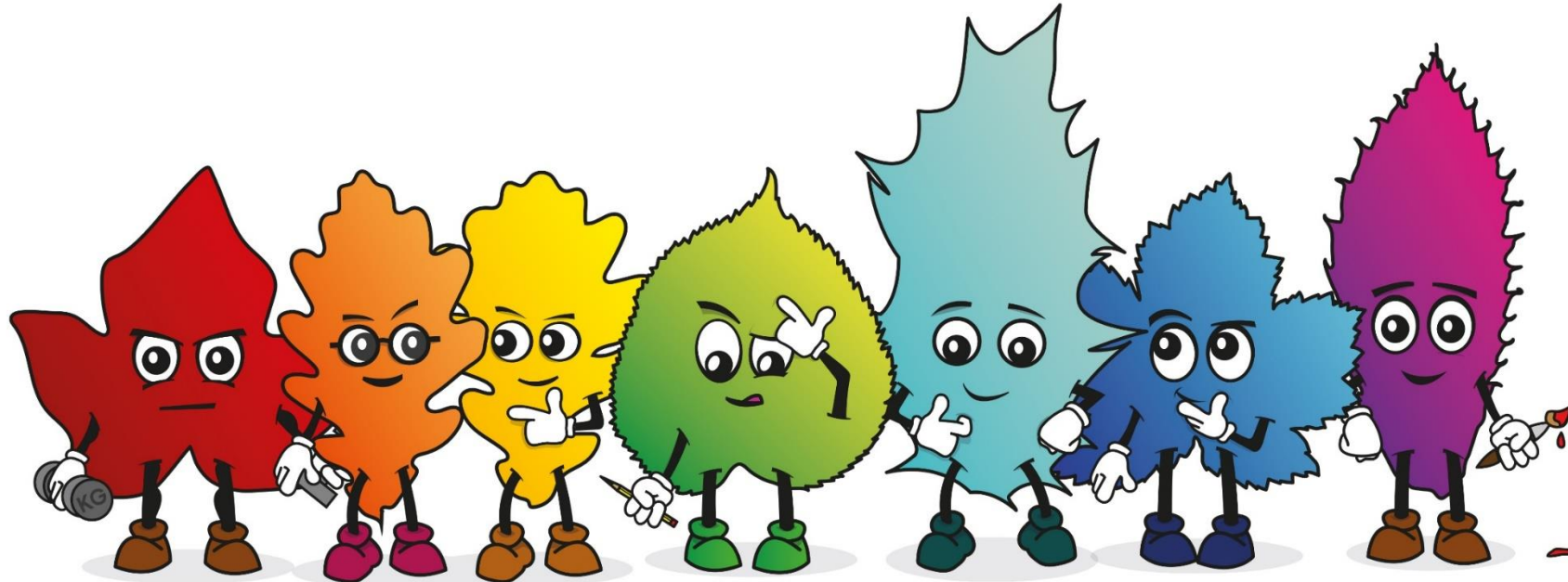

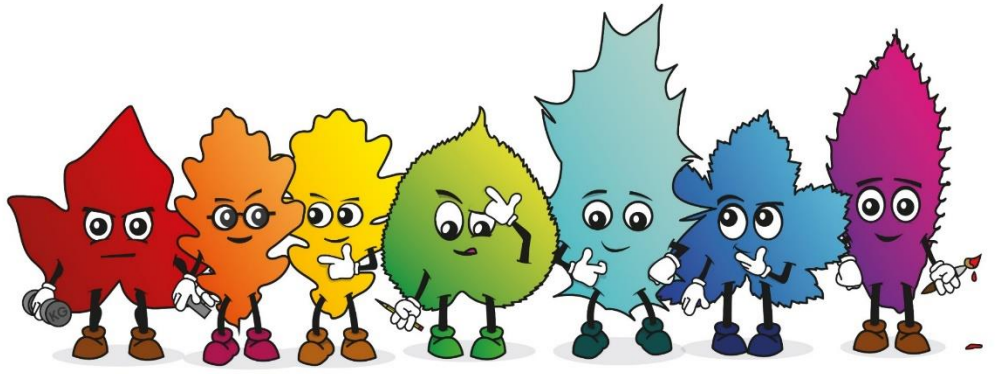
At Freegrounds Junior School we **aspire**-to aim high, **believe**– in who we are and **achieve**-beyond our dreams.

1:00 – 3:00pm – Curriculum subjects (History, French, Science, Art, Games etc.)

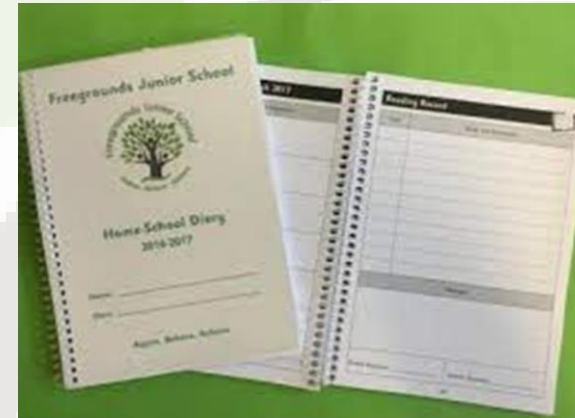
3:00 – 3:20pm – Class story and circle time

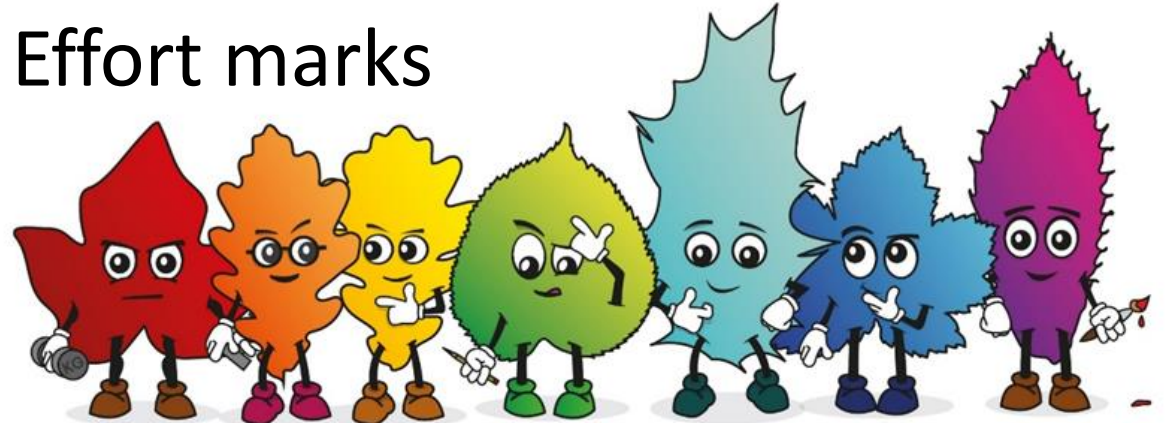

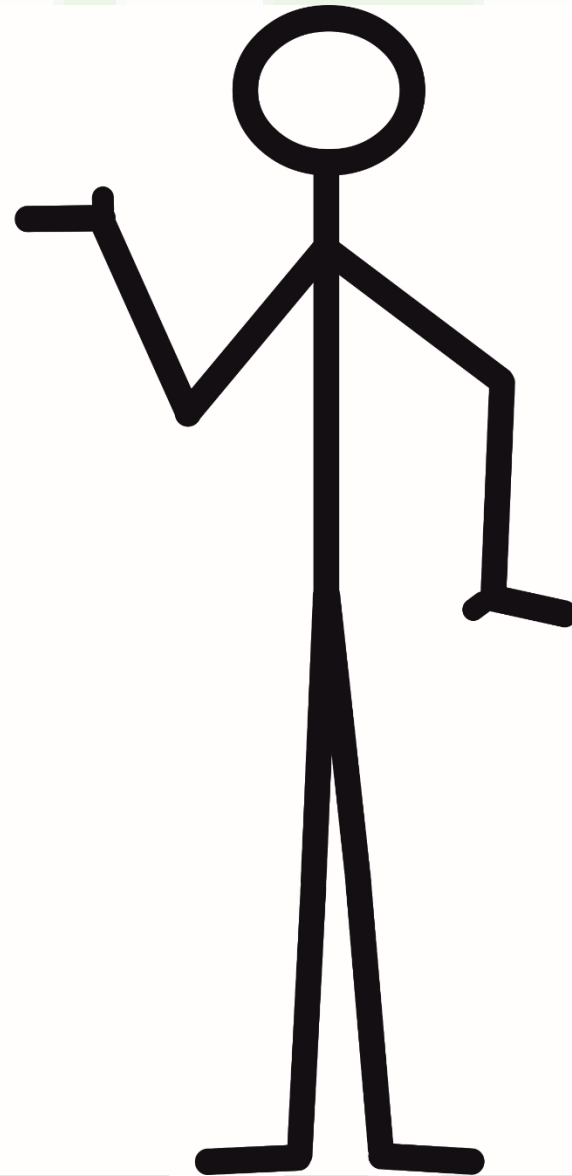
