









| 1 | <p>a)  triangle not a triangle <u>This shape has 3 closed, straight sides and 3 angles.</u></p> <p>b)  triangle not a triangle <u>This shape has 5 sides and 5 angles.</u></p> <p>c)  triangle not a triangle <u>This shape has 3 closed, straight sides and 3 angles.</u></p> <p>d)  triangle not a triangle <u>This shape has 3 closed, straight sides and 3 angles.</u></p> <p>e)  triangle not a triangle <u>This shape only has 2 straight sides.</u></p> <p>f)  triangle not a triangle <u>This shape only has 2 closed sides, 1 is open.</u></p> <p>g)  triangle not a triangle <u>This shape has curved edges.</u></p> |
