Your mission, should you choose to accept it, is to fill the matchbox supplied with as many **DIFFERENT** items as you can!

Prizes will be awarded for the pupil in each year group who has the most items in their matchbox!

Every pupil will be provided with an identical empty matchbox. We would like you to fill it with as many different items as you can, let your imagination run wild and get your parents, siblings, grandparents, friends and neighbours involved with ideas and sponsorship for you!! You could be sponsored per item or just for taking part.

The rules are simple but important so please read carefully:

1. You can only use the matchbox supplied
2. You must be able to close the matchbox with all items inside
3. Please clearly write your name and class on the matchbox, you are welcome to decorate your matchbox but the judges must be able to open it
4. You can only have one of each item, for example you cannot fill your matchbox with grains of rice but you could use different types of seeds
5. All items in your box must be itemised on the form provided and returned with your filled matchbox. All forms will be checked and judge's decision is final. Please ensure you write neatly. Entries will not be accepted without a completed itemised form
6. Please ask as many of your friends and family to sponsor your efforts using the enclosed form. They can sponsor you per item or for taking part. Sponsorship money can be brought into the school office or online payments can be made via your child's Scopay account. (Please amend the balance to the correct amount)
7. Don't forget we are a NUT FREE SCHOOL so no nuts are allowed or items containing nuts
8. Do not include items such as insects, creatures (dead or alive), animal dropping or anything that has come from your body, for example bogies and nail clippings!!
9. Return your box, itemised list and sponsorship form to the school office by Friday November 8th
10. In the event of a tie the judges will carefully check for correct spellings on the itemised lists
